General Meeting held in Brasserie Seppl (42 avenue de la Faïencerie Luxembourg) at 19h00 local time.

1. Introduction by the president Cyrial Talon

Welcome word and follow-up on 2021 events and actions, in particular:

- WAC have been cancelled and there is still risk that 2022 WAC are also cancelled;

- Upset Prevention and Recovery Training (UPRT) is also available and can be done in a Luxembourg ATO (for future professional pilots).
- Instruction is also available in Verdun with Alex and Cyrial on the CR100 that should be back from overhaul in June.
